FROM VILNIUS INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT

CONTI Hotel is located in the Vilnius old town, near to the Vilnius Bus/Railway station. There are several ways to reach CONTI Hotel from Vilnius International Airport (VIA):

a) From the VIA you can take a train going to Vilnius Railway station.

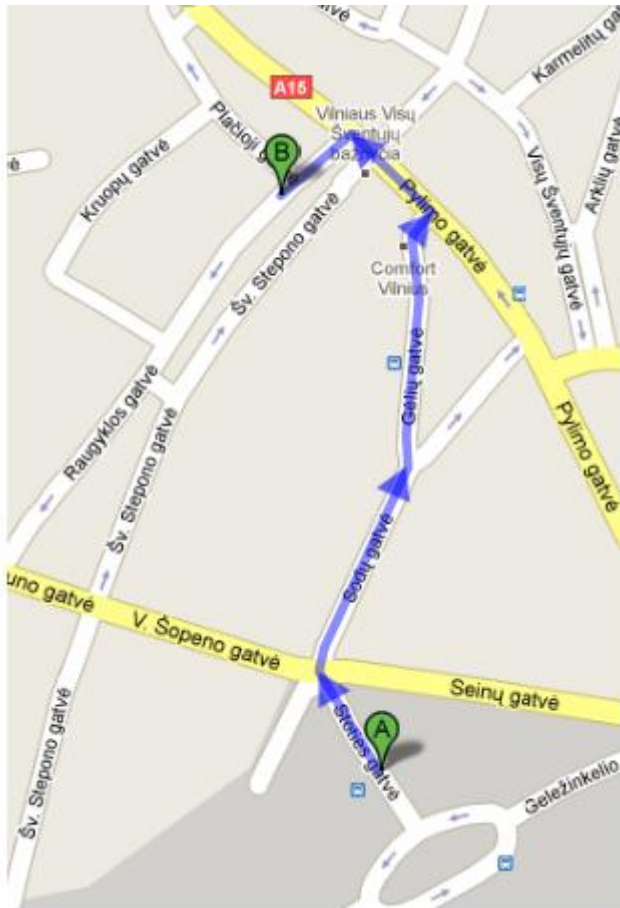

From the Railway station you can take either trolleybuses of following No: 5, 7, and 20 or buses No: 26, 53 and go 1 stop till Rudninku station, and then the hotel is on the opposite side about 20 - 30 meters away. Both trolley and bus tickets you can purchase from drivers; 1 ticket costs there 2,5 Lt (round 0,58 Euro cents – and don't forget that in Lithuania we still do not have Euro and you need to have our national currency that is called Litas (1 Euro is 3,45 Litas).

You can also take a walk from the Railway station to the Hotel as far as it is really very close (round 7 – 10 minutes walk).

b) You can also take a taxi from VIA and go directly to CONTI hotel. Taxi prices are comparatively low in Vilnius, and the ride might cost round 15 – 20 Lt (round 4 – 6 Euro). **Before using a taxi please carefully read the rules for reimbursement of travel costs. Taxi use is only valid for late arrivals (later than 22.23h or earlier than 5.45h)**

Rules for Reimbursement of the travel costs

Travel costs of participants will be refunded after the meeting. But only the travel costs directly related to the project can be reimbursed.

Travel costs are refunded on the principle of the most economical overall expenditure. Only the shortest and most economical route by second-class rail, plane or bus can be reimbursed. Air travel costs higher than an economy class fare are not allowed.

Rail travel must be used for journeys of up to 400 kilometres, except in an emergency or where a sea crossing is involved. For journeys of more than 400 kilometres air travel may be used.

Should your total travel costs exceed **400 EURO**, it is absolutely necessary to contact us before making your reservation.

Participants in DARE meetings should arrive/depart as close as possible to the beginning/end date of the meeting, no further overnight stays can be booked.

Taxi fares shall only be reimbursed where no reasonable public transport is available.

For the reimbursement of travel costs, **originals** of air/train tickets must be provided with the claim form to the organisers.

Participants are asked to bring with them the IBAN code of their bank account (to be received from their bank) to which they want the refunding to be carried out, the BIC code of the bank (also to be received from their bank), the name and address of the bank and the name and address of the account holder. Working this way within the EU transnational bank transfers will be carried out without extra costs.
